Dear Farishioners,

Kerala met with an unusual and unprecedented Flood Disaster. It was so severe that about one million people were displaced. 1.5 million people in shelters of friends and relatives. About 650,000 people are in 2971 Relief Camps. A total of 906,400 hectares of crops were lost. It is estimated that the damages cost about 3 billion dollars. Most of the houses are to be rebuilt.

Presently, people are very short of bath soaps, detergent soaps, tooth brush and paste, dishwashing soap, sanitary napkins, dettol, savlon, nighty, lungi, men and women undergarments, towels, blankets, torch lights, candles, match boxes, kerosene stove, slippers, buckets, t-shirts, utensils, cooking vassals, cutlery, eating plates etc. The immediate challenge is to build new houses for those who lost their homes and to clean and make the partially damaged homes as liveable shelters. Cleaning is a big task as most of the houses are filled with mud and filthy wastes.

The great service the volunteers and many of the government officials performed is much appreciable. Especially the fisher men did remarkable service, to rescue the people in the flood. Many churches, schools convents and private homes were opened to receive the victims whose house was lost or unliveable.

The Malayalees around the world joined hands together to help Kerala in this turbulent situation. It is also worth mentioning that some foreign countries also showed their gesture of concern by pledging financial aid. The UAE ruler pledged 100 million dollars to rebuild Kerala. Many rich business men pledged to help according to their capacity. As a governing Board Member of the Canadian Council of Churches, J have appealed to the Executive to consider helping Kerala this time. The Secretary informed that an emergency Executive will be held soon to discuss this matter.

Our Catholicos, H.H. Baselios Marthoma Paulos II has sent an appeal Kalpana to all the churches under the Malanakra Orthodox churches to help the disaster victims. We, at St. Gregorios Malankara Orthodox Church of Toronto started collecting donations for this. The Flood disaster fund was inaugurated by receiving a donation from Babu Zacharia on August 19 at our church.

Let us join our hands together to show our love and fraternity for the victims and let us pray for God's mercy to the victims to handle the present situation.


