Dearly Beloved,

Greetings to you in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ!

Sixth Sunday of Great Lent - Healing the Blind (St John 9:1-41) - Catholicate Day

Blindness can be curable. Here in the text, Jesus heals a man who was born blind. Their meeting happened on the way. This act of healing was done after His disciples enquiring on the role of sin behind a human disability. The general notion was, for any human defect, it could be because of sin committed by the victim or the parents. They might had also thought likewise because Jesus, while healing the paralysed man, forgiven his sins. Here Jesus rules out the possibility of sin and brings in the reason as God's glory to be manifested. There could be situations which reject conventional ideas got deep rooted in a culture or school of thought. We now realise, many 'take it for granted' notions have been questioned and abolished by the current Pandemic.

What Jesus has done for his healing? He spit on the ground, made it into mud and pasted it on his eyes. This reveals the mightiness and power of the Lord who could transform any situation using anything. It also points to the possibility that lies within humans. The real medicine has got contained in us. We would need only to bring it out! Nature also keeps wonderful healing elements in it. Most of the illnesses started to hit human lives after we had begun distancing from it. We moved away from soil, woods and direct experiencing of nature which has made us an endangered species. Now we cannot stand even a single sneeze!

What the Lord and humans have to do with mud? It is the realisation about our origin. God created human with mud and called him Adam. 'Adama' in Hebrew means red soil. Towards the end of funeral service, soil would be spread over the body with the ceremonial statement 'you are soil, you would turn to soil'.

Jesus the Son, who is one among the Holy Trinity, Co-Creator, has recreated the eye balls and rectified the distorted part. The same Lord is alive and powerful enough to rectify any distortion affecting the human race.

God is ready to act. But He wants human cooperation through acts of faith. This is more significant nowadays. Jesus asked the blind to go to the pool of Siloam and to take a wash. The Lord has done His part. What already has been initiated should be completed by human. Think if the blind had not gone to wash, would the healing had taken place? When hard situations arise, humans tend to ask, if there is God why such things occur? Here is the answer. What God had made, done, initiated, rest of things would be human responsibility. The Creator God had given His children a perfect world with both perfecting and distorting possibilities through their life and actions. Whom should we blame for the current situation of fear and anxiety? God has given us the privilege to be part of His creating and sustaining work. We are that dignified and have been entrusted with a great mission. Rather than crying for rights, better we try our best to carry out our duties as His beloved children and dutiful citizens of His Kingdom. Simply wash, He would heal!!!



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External blindness can be curable. If it is internal, it would be more difficult to cure. The attitude of Synagogue leaders reveals how pathetically they had lost their right vision. Internal blocking of vision would need harder healing measures. It is because that would be possible only from within and the treatment will have to be taken by the self. This is a reminder to all those who are hypocritical and thinking they have the best of vision but actually what they do bring harm to everyone.

Catholicate Day

In the aftermath of COVID 19 outbreak, and under the shadow of sadness over missing Holy Liturgical experience, Church has celebrated Catholicate Day. It's time for us to cooperate with the Government and its various departments for the integrated attempts to eradicate the virus.
